5.2 ICT & DEEP TECH ACCELERATOR

An organization set up to empower ICT & deep tech startups by providing advanced resources and technological support, enhancing their market-ready solutions, market linkages while fortifying their business strategies, thereby facilitating easier access to investment from venture capitalists and angel investors, shall be considered as ICT & DEEP TECH ACCELERATOR.

An Eligible ICT & Deep Tech Accelerator should:

- A. Have been in the business of incubation for more than 3 years and supported more than 20 start-ups of which at least 5 have received non-public investment. OR
 - Having targeted accelerator programs with an experience of running at least 3 groups with 5-10 startups in each group.
- B. Have operations in India.
- C. Have necessary space and infrastructure to carry out activities for the ICT & deep tech start-ups.
- D. Demonstrate capabilities with regard to:
 - i. Supporting ICT & Deep Tech Start-Ups for domestic and international market immersion.
 - ii. Network/Connect with Venture Capitalist/Angel Investors.
 - iii. On-boarded with leading business mentors.
 - iv. Structured group for accelerating ICT & deep tech software product start-ups.

5.3 ICT & DEEP TECH START-UP

ICT & deep tech startup must meet the definition of start up as declared by the Government of India, as updated from time to time, and should be working in the IT/ITeS sector as defined in section 2.5.3 of 'Modification and Addendum to the Gujarat IT/ITeS Policy (2022-27)'. Some of the major consideration for eligible ICT & deep tech Startup are mentioned as the following-

- A. Start-up is a private limited company (as defined in the Companies Act, 2013), or a registered partnership firm (registered under section 59 of the Partnership Act, 1932) or a limited liability partnership (under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2002). Furthermore, the entity would be considered as a start-up up to ten years from the date of incorporation / registration.
- B. The entities' turnover should not exceed INR 100 Crore in any of the financial year since its incorporation / registration.
- C. Any entity formed by splitting up or reconstruction of a business already in existence shall not be considered as a 'Eligible Startup.'
- D. An entity is working towards innovation, development or improvement of products, processes, or services, or if it is a scalable business model with a high potential of employment generation or wealth creation.
- E. Eligible ICT & deep tech Start-ups will be entitled to benefits under this policy till they cross any of the following milestones, whichever is earlier:
 - i. Number of employees on payroll crosses 10
 - ii. Turnover exceeds INR 100 Cr per annum.
