Earlier in the similar tender (Comprehensive Terrain Information System) by CGM, clear cut 'Units' and estimated 'Quantities' were mentioned/ defined in SOR so that all the bidders would quote uniformly.</p> <p>In the absence of Common 'Units' and estimated 'Quantity', different agencies may quote in different 'Units' and 'Quantities' which will lead to price variation and affect the ultimate outcome of the tender due to huge cost implications. Further in the absence of the Common 'Units' and estimated 'Quantity', it shall be difficult for the department to compare & evaluate various price bids.</p> <p>Hence in the interest of the project, we kindly request department to specify Common 'Units' and estimated 'Quantity' at least for "1.2 Implementation Cost" which will also help department later to make payment to the bidder as per the actual quantities executed.</p>	See the corrigendum
