Higher turnover doesn't necessarily shows the strength of a company as a whole, instead GIL could have bundled the average turnover with no. of schools implemented. Never the less, we suggest Department to reduce the amount of annual turnover in order to maximize participation, else it might focus only on 1-2 System integrators in Edutech industry.
