Gujarat Informatics Limited (hereinafter referred to as "GIL"), intend to invite offers through e-Tendering route for supply, installation, commissioning and maintenance of KU Band Dish Antenna with DTH System & TV on behalf of Commissionerate of Women & Child Development, Gandhinagar. (Tender no. HWT130819576).

Eligibility Criteria for the bidder:

1. The Bidder should be a company registered in India under companies Act 1956/2013 and operating in India since last Three years as on bid submission date. Certificates of incorporation **AND** Self -Declaration Certificates and copies of required certificates
2. The bidder should have **total** sum of turnover of **Rs. 20 Crore (Minimum)** during the last three financial years as on 31.03.2019. The copies of Audited Annual Accounts for last three years shall be uploaded along with the bid. In Case of Unaudited Balance sheet for the Financial year 18-19, provisional CA certificate is allowed. **(Form no. E-1)**
3. The bidder should in the field of **ICT/IT/ITES** in India and should be in existence since **last 3 years** as on last date of bid submission.
4. The bidder must have one office in Gujarat. Please upload the copy of any two of the following: Property tax bill/Electricity Bill/Telephone Bill/VAT/CST Registration/Lease agreement. **(Form no. E-2). In case, bidder do not have office in Gujarat, bidder should give undertaking to open office in Gujarat within 45 days from the date of empanelment.**
5. Bidder should not be blacklisted/debarred in last 5 years from the bid submission date by any Ministry of Government of India or by any State Government of India or any of the Government PSUs at the time of bidding. Self-Declaration / Certificate / affidavit mentioning that the Bidder is not blacklisted/debarred as per the clause should be submitted.
6. Bidder should quote TV from those OEM who have average annual turnover of Rs. 1000 crore or more globally during last 3 financial years. **(Form no. E-3).**
i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19. If the country of origin of OEM follows April to March next year as the financial year.
If the country of origin of OEM follows (i.e. January to December) as the financial year, then the financial turnover of the OEM would be considered as per calendar year for 2016, 2017, 2018.
7. The bidder should be authorized by its OEM for TV & KU Band Dish Antenna with DTH System to quote the bid **(Form no. E-4).**
8. OEM of KU Band Dish Antenna with DTH System should be from listed empaneled vendors of "Prasar Bharati", Govt. of India.

Note:

1. All the proposed equipment should not be declared End-of-Support by the OEMs for next 5 years and should not be end of production for next one year from the date of issuance of LOI.
2. Bidders who wish to participate in this bid will have to register on <https://gil.nprocure.com>. Further bidders who wish to participate in online bids will have to procure Digital Certificate as per Information Technology Act 2000 using which they can sign their electronic bids. Bidders can procure the same from (n) code solutions – a division of GNFC Ltd., or any other agency licensed by Controller of Certifying Authority, Govt. of India. Bidders who already have a valid Digital Certificate need not procure a new Digital Certificate.

The terms and conditions are as follows:

1. The last date of submission of bid is mentioned on the website <https://gil.nprocure.com>. **No physical bids will be accepted under normal circumstances.** However, GIL reserves the right to ask the bidders to submit the bid and/or any other documents in physical form.
2. The bid is non-transferable.
3. **The Bidder may quote only one option (i.e. only one product can be quoted) against each item.** Bidders are required to mention make & Model of the product (Do not write "OEM" against items as bidders are expected to give make & model of the product).
4. The bidder will have to supply, install, commissioning & maintain and provide operational training for supplied hardware, operating software and peripherals and carry out necessary integration at end user office.
5. In case the quoted Item is not available in the market, the bidder will have to supply Higher Version/replacement of that Item in the quoted cost in the same time duration with prior approval of GIL. No "End of Life" product should be quoted to minimize such instances. (Make & Model quoted by the bidder should be available till the bid validity, duly supported for spares/OEM support for warranty period).
6. The Bidder shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and GIL will in no case will be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of conduct or outcome of bidding process.
7. The bidder has to upload the compliance letter on its letter head duly signed by the authorized signature & other supporting documents as asked for in the bid in scanned format. Failing to submit the same or non-compliance/deviation from any bid terms and conditions, eligibility criteria or technical specifications may result in rejection of the bid.
8. The Bidder has to examine all instructions, forms, terms, conditions and specifications in the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of its bid.
9. Amendment of Bidding Documents (Corrigendum)
 - 9.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, GIL may, for any reason, whether its own initiative or in response to the clarification request by a prospective bidder, modify the bidding documents.
 - 9.2 The corrigendum will be published on website <https://gil.nprocure.com>.
 - 9.3 In order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time to take into consideration the amendments while preparing their bids GIL, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of bids.
10. Bid Currency – Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.
11. The Bidder will have to remit **Non refundable Bid Processing Fees of Rs. 17,700/- & Earnest Money Deposit (E.M.D.) of Rs. 14,00,000/-** on or before bid due date & time given in the bid in a sealed cover at GIL office with the heading "**Bid Processing fees & EMD for the e-Tender no. HWT130819576** for supply, installation, commissioning and maintenance of KU Band Dish Antenna with DTH System & TV on behalf of Commissionerate of Women & Child Development, Gandhinagar."
 - ✓ Bid processing fees must be in the form of Demand Draft in the name of "Gujarat Informatics Ltd." payable at Gandhinagar along with the covering letter. Please affix the stamp of your company on the overleaf of demand draft.
 - ✓ EMD shall be submitted in the form of **Demand Draft OR** in the form of an **unconditional Bank Guarantee (which should be valid for 9 months from the last date of bid submission)** of All Nationalized Bank including the public sector bank or banks (operating in India having branch at Ahmedabad/ Gandhinagar) as per the G.R. no. EMD/10/2018/18/DMO dated 16.04.2018 issued by Finance Department or further instruction issued by Finance department time to time in the name of

“Gujarat Informatics Ltd.” payable at Gandhinagar (as per prescribed format given at **as per prescribed format given at Annexure A**) and must be submitted along with the covering letter.

Note: Failing to submit physical covers of EMD and bid processing fees at GIL on or before the bid submission date & time, may lead to the rejection of the bid.

12. In case of non-receipt of Bid Processing fees & EMD as mentioned above within prescribed time the bid will be rejected by GIL as non-responsive.
13. Unsuccessful bidder's E.M.D. will be returned as promptly as possible but not later than 15 days after the expiration of the period of bid validity OR upon the successful Bidder signing the Contract, and furnishing the Performance Bank Guarantee @ **10%** of the total order value as prescribed by GIL, whichever is earlier.
14. In exceptional circumstances, GIL may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its E.M.D. A Bidder granting the request will not be permitted to modify its bid.
15. The Successful bidder has to submit Performance Bank Guarantee @ **10%** of total order value within 15 days from the date of issue of Purchase order (for warranty period + extra 3 months) All Nationalized Bank including the public sector bank or banks (operating in India having branch at Ahmedabad/ Gandhinagar) as per the G.R. no. EMD/10/2018/18/DMO dated 16.04.2018 issued by Finance Department or further instruction issued by Finance department time to time. (The draft of Performance Bank Guarantee is attached herewith).
16. Successful bidders will have to sign the contract upon receiving the Purchase order with the purchaser(s) within 15 working days from the date of Purchase order. (The draft of the Contract form is attached herewith)
17. The successful Bidder's E.M.D. will be returned upon the Bidder signing the Contract, and furnishing the Performance Bank Guarantee @ **10%** of the total order value, offer of inspection of the ordered material, completion of GIL inspection, Delivery and installation of all hardware at respective sites and after completion of bid validity whichever is later.
18. If the successful bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee & sign the Contract Form within prescribed time limit, the EMD of the successful bidder will be forfeited. GIL also reserves the right to blacklist such bidder from participating in future tenders if sufficient cause exists.”
19. The E.M.D. may be forfeited:
 - (a) if a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity
 - (b) In case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails:
 - (i) If the bidder is found to be involved in fraudulent practices.
 - (ii) If the bidder fails to submit the copy of purchase order & acceptance thereof.
 - (iii) "If the successful bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee & sign the Contract Form within prescribed time limit, the EMD of the successful bidder will be forfeited. GIL also reserves the right to blacklist such bidder from participating in future tenders if sufficient cause exists.
20. Termination for Default
 - 20.1 The Purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the Bidder (after providing notice/cure period of 30 days), terminate the Contract in whole or part:
 - a) if the bidder fails to deliver any or all of the Goods within time limit, or within any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser or
 - b) if the Bidder fails to perform any obligation(s) under the Contract/Purchase order.
 - c) If the Bidder, in the judgment of the Purchaser has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract.

The Purchaser shall be liable to pay the bidder for all the products delivered and services rendered up to the effective date of termination.

For the purpose of this clause:

“Corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of any thing of value of influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.

“fraudulent practice : a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the purchaser, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the purchaser of the benefits of free and open competition;”

- 20.2 In the event the Purchaser terminates the Contract in whole or in part, pursuant to Clause 20.1 above, the Purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner, as it deems appropriate, Goods or Services similar to those undelivered, and the Bidder shall be liable to the Purchaser for any excess costs for such similar Goods or Services. However, the Bidder shall continue the performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated.
21. Price shall be inclusive of all freight, forwarding, transit insurance and installation charges.
22. Prices shall be in Indian Rupees. The prices shall strictly be submitted in the given format. The tax (GST) components as applicable shall be mentioned separately in the respective columns.
23. Late Bids – The bidder will not be able to submit the bid after final submission date and time.
24. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids
- 24.1 No bids will be allowed to be modified subsequent to the final submission of bids.
- 24.2 No bid will be allowed to be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiry of the bid validity. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval will result in the forfeiture of bidder’s E.M.D.
25. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidder’s representatives, who choose to attend. The Bidder’s representatives who are present shall sign a register/attendance sheet evidencing their attendance. The representative will be held responsible for all commitments made on behalf of the bidder and that will be considered valid for all further dealings related to this tender process. In the absence of the bidder(s), the tender committee may choose to open the bids as per the prescribed schedule.
26. The Bidder’s names, bid modifications or withdrawals, discounts and the presence or absence of relevant E.M.D. and such other details as GIL/GOG officer(s) at their discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening.
27. **Evaluation of the bids:** After the closing time of bid submission, GIL will verify the submission of Bid Processing Fees & EMD as per bid terms and conditions. The eligibility criteria evaluation will be carried out of the responsive bids. The technical bids of the bidders who are complying with all the eligibility criteria will be opened and evaluated next. The financial bid of the technically qualified bidders will be opened and financially L1 bidder will be decided from the sum total of prices for all line items without tax with warranty and then called for further negotiations if required.
28. As per the provision in Electronics & IT/ITeS Start-up Policy Resolution No. ITS/10/2015/5284/IT dated 6th June, 2016 issued by Department of Science & Technology; in e-Governance project undertaken by Government Departments or its Boards, Corporations or parastatal bodies getting grants from the Government, the chosen solution provider or system integrator will pass on job work or will outsource part of the work of a value ranging between 5% to 10% of the contract value to the eligible start-ups and to students of shortlisted Technical Colleges in Gujarat. In such arrangements, the responsibility of meeting SLAs (Service Level Agreements) will continue to belong to the solution provider or the system integrator.
29. **The bidder will have to offer the inspection in the manner as decided by GIL at successful bidder’s central location at Gandhinagar or Ahmedabad before delivering to the at respective sites. The cost of**

the same has to be borne by the supplier. Any deviation found in the specification of the produced goods or delivered goods after inspection from the tender specifications will lead to the cancellation of the order, forfeiture of EMD/PBG and prohibition in the participation in the future purchase of Government of Gujarat. GIL/GoG will not be responsible for any time delay which may arise due to any deviation from the bid technical specification found at the time of inspection and the bidder has to deliver and install the ordered goods within prescribed time limit.

At the time of inspection, bidder is required to produce OEM's confirmation on OEM's Letter head with Sr. nos. of Equipment, Software supplied (if applicable) for back to back warranty support as per tender terms & conditions.

Successful bidder has to paste non-removable sticker on all line items with details of Tender no., bidder's name, address, contact detail, service center/ help line number and warranty expiry date.

30. The indenter's right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the Goods arrival at Customer Site shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by the Purchaser or its representative prior to the Goods shipment.
31. **Delivery & installation:** Within **60 working days** from the date of confirmed purchase order at respective sites.
32. In case of successful bidder is found in breach of any condition(s) of bid or supply order/work order, at any stage during the course of supply / installation or warranty period, the legal action as per rules/laws, shall be initiated against the empanelled bidder and EMD/PBG shall be forfeited, besides debarring and blacklisting the bidder concerned for the time period as decided by Govt., for further dealings with GoG.
33. Bids shall be valid for **180 days** after the date of financial bid opening. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected as non-responsive. If required, GIL may extend the bid validity for further period from the date of expiry of bid validity in consultation with the successful bidder.
34. Bidders are required to quote all items including optional add-ons as well. Incomplete bids will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected.
35. If applicable, the Bidder/System Integrator will be required to co-ordinate with software vendor to achieve the end-to-end connectivity. This also includes LAN/WAN technologies implementation.
36. Bidder must ensure that the warranty support & service should be available up to delivery locations to provide repairing cum replacement services of faulty equipments within 48 hrs. Bidder is required to provide the name & address & contact details of the firm for providing warranty support & repairing cum replacement service up to delivery locations.
37. **Penalty Clause for delay in delivery & installation**
 - 37.1 If the bidder fails to deliver and install the requisite hardware and software within 60 working days of the issue of the confirmed purchase order, then a sum equivalent to one percent (1 %) of the undelivered item value shall be deducted from the payment for each calendar week of delay or part thereof.
 - 37.2 The amount of penalty for delay in delivery & installation shall be subject to a maximum limit of 10% of the total contract value.
 - 37.3 Delay in excess of 10 weeks will be sufficient to cause for termination of the contract. In that case the Performance Bank Guarantee of the bidder will be forfeited.
 - 37.4 In case, the selected bidder does not supply the ordered items for any reason, the bidder will be liable to pay the difference amount to the purchaser, over and above the performance guarantee, which indenter department has to pay to the next or other selected bidder for purpose of the said items.
38. **Warranty**
 - 38.1 **Warranty:** Comprehensive onsite warranty for **5 years** from the date of installation of equipments.

- 38.2 If any equipment gives continuous trouble, say more than 3 times consecutive in one quarter during the warranty period, the bidder shall replace the same with new equipment without any additional cost to the purchaser.
- 38.3 Maintenance service: Free maintenance services shall be provided by the Bidder during **the period of warranty.**
- 38.4 In case, bidder is not providing satisfactory support & doing unwarranted delay of more than 30 days in providing warranty support, Government offices reserves right to repair the equipment at risk & cost of the bidder.

39. Operational/Warranty period Penalty:

- 39.1 During warranty period, if the complaint is not resolved within 48 hrs the penalty of Rs. 300 per day for TV and within 72 hours the penalty of Rs. 200 per day for other peripherals will be levied. However, if the complaints not resolved within 7 days then from 8th day to 14th day, penalty would be levied @ 150% and from 15th day onwards penalty @ 200% of the above rates would be levied. The amount of penalty will be recovered from the Performance bank guarantee during warranty period.
- 39.2 The amount of Operational/Warranty period Penalty shall be subject to a maximum limit of 10% of the total contract value

Note:

- o Successful bidder should submit the Performance Bank Guarantee @ **10%** of total order value for the duration of (for warranty period + extra 3 months) as per bid requirements. In any case, bidder is required to maintain **10%** PBG at all time during the period of contract. In case of any penalty claimed from the submitted PBG during the contract period, the successful bidder is required to submit the additional PBG of the amount equal to the penalty claimed for the duration up to the validity of original Bank Guarantee.

For example, For 5 years warranty "X" amount of penalty will be claimed during the 5th month of contract period (for, then bidder is required to submit the additional PBG of "X" amount for the period of 58 months i.e. 63 months - 5 months).

- 40. **Payment:** Payment for Goods and Services shall be made by the indenting department in Indian Rupees as follows:
 - 40.1 No advance payment will be made.
 - 40.2 70% payment after successful inspection and delivery at vendor's central location/Warehouse at Gandhinagar/Ahmedabad with required supporting documentary proof. The inspection will be done by GIL. Further, bidder is responsible for delivery of goods at end location/site without any additional cost to department/purchaser.
 - 40.3 25% payment will be made after successful delivery at end location, installation, testing & completion of operational training of the ordered goods.
 - 40.4 Remaining 5% payment will be made after 3 months of successful completion of work of the ordered goods.
 - 40.5 Invoices for payments shall be submitted to department on fortnightly basis i.e. only one invoice in a fortnight. Bidder will have to submit necessary documentary proof and training completion reports.
- 41. GIL's Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids – GIL reserve the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to awarding the Contracts,

without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or bidders of the grounds for such decision.

42. The quantity mentioned in this Bid is as per indent received by GIL. During the validity of Bid, any Govt. Dept can place purchase order for any item at finalized rates under this bid, hence successful vendor will have to accept purchase orders during the validity of Bid period.
43. The tendered quantities are indicative based on requirement received from Dept. The quantities may increase or decrease up to 50% of the bid quantity at the time of finalization, depending upon the change in the requirements/grants available with the purchaser(s), which shall be binding to the bidder.
44. All correction/addition/deletion shall require authorized countersign.
45. **Limitation of Vendor's Liability:** Selected agency's cumulative liability for its obligations under the contract shall not exceed the value of the charges payable by the GIL within the remaining duration of the contract term from the day claim is raised and selected agency shall not be liable for incidental, consequential, or indirect damages including loss of profit or saving.
46. Force Majeure Shall mean and be limited to the following:
 - a) War / hostilities
 - b) Riot or Civil commotion
 - c) Earthquake, flood, tempest, lightening or other natural physical disaster.
 - d) Restrictions imposed by the Government or other statutory bodies which prevents or delays the execution of the order by the BIDDER.

The BIDDER shall advise GIL by a registered letter duly certified by the local statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the above causes of delay within seven (7) days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure Conditions. In the event of delay lasting over two months, if arising out of causes of Force Majeure, GIL reserves the right to cancel the order.

Completion period may be extended to circumstances relating to Force Majeure by the GIL. Bidder shall not claim any further extension for completion of work. GIL/GoG shall not be liable to pay extra costs under any conditions.

The BIDDER shall categorically specify the extent of Force Majeure conditions prevalent in their works at the time of submitting their bid and whether the same have been taken in to consideration or not in their quotations. In the event of any Force Majeure cause, the BIDDER shall not be liable for delays in performing their obligations under this order and the delivery dates can be extended to the BIDDER without being subject to price reduction for delayed delivered, as stated elsewhere.

It will be prerogative of GIL/GoG to take the decision on force major conditions and GIL/GoG decision will be binding to the bidder.

Scope of Services

- All equipments are required to supply, install, test, commission, provide operational training along with warranty during contract period at 1470 various offices (at village level) located within the state of Gujarat covered under Commissionerate of Women & Child Development Department, Gandhinagar. Detail list of 1470 locations located within the state of Gujarat will be given separately.
- Successful Bidder is responsible to carry out all necessary electrification (including Switches, Plugs, Sockets, Cables, Wires, and other accessories) if required, in offices as per rates quoted under this RFP.
- Bidder is responsible to ensure that all the supplied equipments are properly installed & in working condition as per technical and functional requirement of the RFP.
- Bidder will have to provide operational training of supplied hardware to end user at respective location/site and submit training completion reports to the department.
- Bidder will have to provide necessary HDMI Cable, Power Cable, and Audio Video Cable with required length, mounting kit and related accessories (wherever applicable).
- The LED TV shall be capable of getting directly connected to KU Band Dish Antenna through set top box.
- KU Band Dish Antenna should be capable of running in rural environment in extreme weather conditions.
- KU Band Dish Antenna should be installed Industrial quality foundation with quad stand for the dish antenna to be installed on terrace.
- Supplied DTH System should also capable of showing Free to Air Channels.
