### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE 25% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25% of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be as per the Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.  
For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25% of the service provider

The Buyer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation.

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ is the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Source Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension is not allowed by the Buyer.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. 13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders, the Buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional technical specifications in other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done in a category based bid.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply within the stipulated time.
